RETIRED MEMBERS - POLICY 1.02

- 5.09 Retired membership may be granted by the Council on application of a member who has retired from active employment and who provides proof of continued retired status.
 - (b) Retired members shall be required to pay annual fees. If a retired member is over fifty-five (55) or more years of age and has been a member of the Society for fifteen (15) or more years before becoming a retired member, the retired member shall be entitled to a discount on the annual fee as determined by the Council.

CRITERIA FOR PAYMENT OF DUES FOR RETIRED MEMBERS

- 1. If more than fifty-five (55) years of age before retirement and fifteen (15) or more years as a member of the Society the member shall be charged 50 % of current yearly rate.
- 2. If a member is more than fifty-five (55) years of age and twenty-five (25) or more years as a member of the Society the member shall be required to pay the CCTT Levy portion.
- 3. Members or former certified members, who have given exceptional and meritorious service to the Society, shall be considered a life member. Life members as per Section 5.07 shall be entitled to all the rights of certified members without payment of annual fees and subject to all other provisions of the By-laws and the rules.
